This is a technique that benefits macro/close-up photography and deep landscapes. The technique is most applicable to cameras that allow aperture adjustments to control depth of field. We will discuss and demonstrate using the stacking features in Adobe Photoshop, other available apps and built-in stacking features of some of the newer mirrorless cameras.
