
Photography Club of Sun City - April Newsletter

Studio News

Walk-in Mentoring Sessions - John Burrack would like to offer walk-in mentoring sessions during his previously scheduled PFW 100 class dates and times (canceled due to lack of registrations), subject to interest. The four sessions previously scheduled were April 4th, 12th, 18th and 25th (they remain on the club's calendar on these dates as Fundamentals 100 - All Cameras). John would be available from 9:30 - 10 am for an open Q&A session. After Q&A time, John will be available for one-on-one mentoring sessions for camera set-ups, photo editing, printing and/or mounting/matting photos. Walk-ins would welcome after 10 am through 11:30 am for mentoring or Open Studio support. Session times would be limited to 15 minutes if there are more than 2 people.

First Saturday Sales: This event takes place on Saturday, April 6th, from 10 am to 12 pm in the photography studio and is open to all residents of Sun City.

Photo Studio Exhibit: The studio is now home to 36 new pieces of art by 24 fellow members. Stop by the studio to view this new exhibit - it will be available through October 2024.

Printing Price Increases: Effective Mar 1st, printing charges increased 20% to offset continuing increases for printing inks and printing paper. Prices for print mounting materials (Kool Tac) and mat boards will remain the same.


EDUCATION PROGRAM



Welcome to the Spring Semester, which runs from April 2nd through June 14th. Registration for 30 classes opened on March 22nd, and almost 79% of the "paid seats" have already been sold. There are still many classes with openings. You can view the <u>course catalog here</u> and register for open classes using the <u>registration</u> <u>form here</u> - both are also available from the <u>Education page</u> of the club's website.

Of note, the last Photo Club Orientation class until the Fall semester is being offered on April 29th from 10:00 am to noon. This class is offered at no-charge and is geared toward new or newer members as a great way to learn about important details about your Photography Club. Some topics covered include field trips, competition tips and rules, educational programs, Special Interest Groups (SIGs), studio equipment and resources, as well as a review of the great features and information available on the club's website. There are seats still available. If you haven't already attended or want a refresher, submit your registration using the registration form here. You won't be disappointed.

The results of the Smartphone Camera Use Survey are still being finalized! There were 139 responses representing a 35% response rate from our membership. Of those members who responded, 83% are Android users – April Fools - only 17% surveyed are Android users \therefore , 55% use their smartphone camera as their primary camera and many of these are looking for the "next level" of training - not just the introductory level. Thank you to all who responded. We gathered a lot of great information that will help us put together future classes to meet your phone photography educational needs. We will be sharing more details in future newsletters as we drill down on the response specifics.



Finally, summer will be here before you know it. The Education Committee is thinking about the possibility of offering educational opportunities in the form of "pop-ups." Pop-ups are informal classes/meets for club members who remain in Sun City during those HOT summer months! The USAF Thunderbirds Airshow at Joint Base Charleston - 2024

April 20, 2024, from 9 AM to 6 PM

The Charleston Airshow is a spectacular aerial event showcasing a variety of civilian and military performances, demonstrations and displays taking place at Joint Base (JB) Charleston on April 20th and April 21st. We have scheduled a field trip on Saturday April 20th from 9 AM to 6 PM. Come watch the "Heroes of Flight" show featuring one of this country's elite military air demonstration "The USAF Thunderbirds"! You will not be disappointed!

If you plan to drive, you will need a Base Parking Pass.

If you plan to drive, you must order a Base Parking Pass for your vehicle to get on base for the event. The parking pass is also your ticket for up to 4 people per vehicle to enter the Airshow. According to the Charleston Airshow website, Base Parking Passes are still available at this time!

There are a limited number of Base Parking Passes available for each show and are issued on a first come first served basis. When the max number of Base Parking Passes has reached capacity, a "sold out" notice will be posted and no more Base Parking Passes will be issued. The Base Parking Passes only limit the number of vehicles entering the base and not the number of people, so if you get a Base Parking Pass, please consider taking 3-passengers in your vehicle.

There are two parking areas close to the flight line designated as the Blue & Red Parking lots. If available, select the Blue Parking area, then the group can park together if possible. Handicap parking is available for vehicles with Handicap Placards.

Important

The Base Parking Pass Must Be Printed & Ready to Be Scanned by Joint Base Charleston's Military Security Personnel at the entrance and they will not accept any mobile phone images of the base parking pass.

The Beidler Audubon Forest - 2024 Friday May 10, 2024, from 7 AM to 3 PM

The Francis Beidler Audubon Forest, located in Harleyville, SC is an 18,000-acre bird and wildlife sanctuary that offers a beauty unsurpassed in the South Carolina Lowcountry. Beidler is the world's largest old-growth cypress-tupelo swamp forest and has vibrant ecosystem untouched for millennia. Enjoy thousand-year-old trees, a range of wildlife, and the quiet flow of blackwater. You will have the opportunity to photograph Prothonotary Warblers, Barred Owls, Summer Tanagers, songbirds, reptiles and more. The Beidler Forest is unique because you will be high & dry above the swamp photographing from the safety of the 1.75-mile boardwalk! Head for the treetops! This is a beautiful location and is worth the visit! A group lunch is planned!

Competition Category Advancements

Club Members Zoom Into New Levels With "Reflections"



Kathy Leonard to Expert Sue VanDette to Advanced Shashi Cooduvalli to Intermediate

We reached out to these members to speak with them after they advanced to the next level in competition.

Kathy Leonard, who advanced to the Expert level, moved to Sun City in the fall of 2017 and is from Ames, Iowa. Kathy says, "I knew I wanted to pursue photography after retirement, and the fact that Sun City had a Photography Club was an important factor in my decision to live here." She joined the club a few months after moving to Sun City and, "I immediately started participating in as many classes as possible." Her first competition was at the novice level in January of 2018. "So you can see it was a long road for me to advance to the expert level," she said. Kathy says in her early competitions, "I remember being in awe of the

photos produced at all levels, and especially those taken by the experts. I must admit that I am a bit apprehensive about now having to compete at that level, but excited at the same time to see how my photos measure up to those of the veteran photographers." She encourages those who feel comfortable entering competitions to do so, adding "It's a fun way to see how your photography measures up to others in your level of competition."

Sue VanDette, moving up to Advanced level, has lived in Sun City for about three years and is from Buffalo, New York. Reflecting on how she got involved in the Photography Club, she said, "We (she and her husband Rick) went to a cell phone seminar that the Photography Club put on for all Sun City Residents back in late 2022," and she went on to say, "We were impressed." Sue described it as a "great meeting" where they received valuable cell phone tips, motivating their decision to join the Photography Club at the beginning of 2023. Sue recalls Guest Speaker John Barkley at the February 2023 Photography Club meeting inspired her when he spoke about "finding joy in your photography," and "taking photos of what makes your heart sing." She hung on to those words and said there are many things she loves about the club, "Classes have great value and have been a real treat to me." February 2023 was also the first competition that Sue and Rick decided to enter. She said, "We jumped in with both feet and I don't think we've missed a competition since. Being a part of the competition helps sharpen your skills and provides great feedback from the judges." Sue continued, "It helps you become a better photographer by entering the competition." Sue only shoots with "the best camera I have," and that is her cell phone, the iPhone 14 Pro. To her, the club's motto of "Friends Helping Friends," says it perfectly as to what the Photography Club is all about.

Shashi Cooduvalli, who advanced to Intermediate, moved to Sun City in June of 2022 and is originally from State College, Pennsylvania. He says he joined the Photography Club last fall mentioning, "I've taken a few classes. It's a new beginning for me." He submitted photos to the competitions in October and November of 2023 and again this March. Shashi began photographing with his iPhone but has recently acquired a Sony camera, now using both. He has an incredibly positive personal perspective on the competition regarding encouraging others to participate. He says, "If you don't submit, you don't win. I am not so keen on competitions." And he says he "doesn't take it seriously. It's a learning experience." He feels, "I'm truly a novice," and is looking forward to improving in "different areas of photography," though he is leaning towards landscape photography, Shashi remains undecided on a specialty.
